On this occasion, the Deputy Prime Minister for Reintegration expressed his gratitude and high appreciation for the work carried in the perimeter of the Security Zone by the military contingent of the Peacekeeping Forces of the Republic of Moldova, the delegation of the Republic of Moldova to the Joint Control Commission, as well as by the responsible representatives of all national public institutions (central, territorial and local), whose daily efforts ensure the maintenance of peace, security and public order in this area.

Peacekeepers and Moldovan public servants were awarded honorary distinctions and certificates of merit, and were promoted in military rank for their exemplary performance of their duties and outstanding professional achievements.
