Moldovan PM discusses with local public authorities from laloveni district



6 March 2025, Ialoveni - The support provided by the government for the modernization projects of the communities, the challenges, achievements and priorities of the authorities have been among the topics discussed by Prime Minister Dorin Recean and local officials of the Ialoveni district.

"The government is alongside each mayor who wants to develop the community they lead. With joint efforts and development partners' support, Moldova can become a country where people want to stay, a European country," emphasized Prime Minister Dorin Recean.
