On Sunday, August 31, the Head of Government in Chisinau will inaugurate the Republic of Moldova Day at the Osaka World Expo, an event dedicated to promoting the image of our country in the Land of the Rising Sun.

At the same time, on Monday, September 1, Prime Minister Dorin Recean will have a meeting with his Japanese counterpart, Shigeru Ishiba, to discuss strengthening bilateral relations.
