

Negotiations' dynamics in Transnistrian settlement process discussed by the Deputy Prime Minister, Olga Cebotari, and the British Ambassador to the Republic of Moldova, Steven Fisher



08.04.2021, Chisinau – The Deputy Prime Minister for Reintegration, Olga Cebotari, met today with the Ambassador of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the Republic of Moldova, Steven Fisher.

The interlocutors exchanged views on the evolution of the Moldovan-British relations, the progress made in the Transnistrian settlement negotiations, the regional pandemic situation and the measures taken at the national level to protect the health of the population.

The Deputy Prime Minister spoke about the main directions of activity on the Transnistrian settlement (human rights, freedom of movement, anti-COVID-19 immunization), the dynamics in fulfilling the commitments on vehicles' transportation and the efforts to keep the existing negotiations formats active and productive.

Olga Cebotari also thanked the British authorities for supporting the Republic of Moldova in continuing the democratic, economic and social transformations, as well as in implementing various projects to promote the confidence-building measures among people from both banks of Nistru.

In turn, His Excellency expressed the full openness to continue the cooperation and to expand the necessary support in areas of mutual interest.
