

Working visit of the Deputy Prime Minister Oleg Serebrian to the villages of Holercani and Ustia in the Dubăsari District



On June 29, the Deputy Prime Minister for Reintegration Oleg Serebrian, together with the representatives of the Reintegration Policies Bureau and the Chişinău Territorial Office of the State Chancellery, made a working visit to the village of Holercani and Ustia in the Dubăsari district, where they met with representatives of public institutions, residents and economic agents from the area.

The Deputy Prime Minister documented on the socio-economic situation at the local level and was informed about current issues in Holercani and Ustia and related to the functioning of basic institutions (kindergartens, schools, cultural centers, medical institutions). In this context, opportunities were highlighted to promote new development and modernization projects with social impact for the community.

Oleg Serebrian assured that the Government of the Republic of Moldova will continue to provide all the necessary support to overcome the existing difficulties and reiterated the call to local public authorities to be actively involved in the development of projects, which will later serve to attract investments in the localities of the Security Zone.
