

Further consultations on the Transnistrian settlement held between the acting Deputy Prime Minister Olga Cebotari and the Head of the OSCE Mission to the Republic of Moldova Claus Neukirch



22.06.2021, Chisinau – The acting Deputy Prime Minister Olga Cebotari discussed with the Head of the OSCE Mission to the Republic of Moldova Claus Neukirch aspects of the negotiation process on the Transnistrian settlement, the dynamics of the dialogue between Chisinau and Tiraspol in the established formats, and the identification of viable solutions to current issues. The readiness of the Moldovan side to engage actively and without any preconditions in a new round of "5+2" negotiations was reiterated.

Olga Cebotari stressed the importance of fully respecting the principles and procedures agreed in the negotiation process, as well as the need to honor commitments on issues of vital interest to residents on both banks of Nistru, in particular with regards to respecting and guaranteeing the fundamental human rights and freedoms.

The Head of the OSCE Mission expressed appreciation for the efforts made so far by the Chisinau authorities and encouraged to continue a constructive dialogue and to achieve positive results.

The officials agreed that they will maintain constant communication on topics of common interest.
