

Deputy Prime Minister Vlad Kulminski met the Special Representative of the Russian Federation in the Transnistrian settlement process, Vitalii Treapitsin



12.10.2021, Chisinau – Deputy Prime Minister Vlad Kulminski held a meeting with the Special Representative of the Russian Federation in the Transnistrian settlement process, Vitalii Treapitsin.

The officials exchanged views on the Transnistrian settlement process during the talks.

Chisinau expressed in this context its openness to solve the existing issues related to documentation with neutral license numbers, but also outlined the need to improve the activity of the sectoral working groups, to continue the dialogue on all current topics on the negotiations agenda and to take concrete actions to tackle them for the benefit of citizens on both banks of the Nistru River.

Vlad Kulminski underlined the openness of Chisinau for having a consistent dialogue with all stakeholders involved on the existing dialogue platforms. The Deputy Prime Minister stressed the importance of unconditional resumption of negotiations in the 5+2 format, with a perspective for advancing the strategic goal to identify a sustainable and comprehensive solution to the Transnistrian issue, exclusively through peaceful and diplomatic approaches.

It was emphasized that escalations must be avoided and that dialogue must be conducted responsibly, without threats, taking into account the difficult regional situation.

Officials also called for a new round of 5 + 2 negotiations in Stockholm in the near future to discuss the implementation of the agreements and move forward.
