

The experts in the field of telecommunications and postal services met after a break of more than two years



On August 17, in an online format, the first meeting between the working groups for telecommunications and postal services from Chisinau and Tiraspol in the current year took place (the last meeting was held on July 21, 2020). The delegation from Chisinau was led by the coordinator of the working group, Lilia Dabija, the Secretary-General of the Ministry of Infrastructure and Regional Development.

During the meeting, the progress on the implementation of the Protocol Decision "Regarding the organization of the interaction in the field of telecommunications" signed on November 25, 2017 was discussed, and the measures taken by Chisinau to make its implementation possible were reviewed, with the existing objective implications in this regard being reiterated once again. Thus, an agreement was reached on the need to receive real proposals from the experts from Tiraspol, so that the experts from the right bank could examine them.

On the aspect of the use of the radio spectrum resources, which is a public property of the Republic of Moldova, the experts from Chisinau mentioned that the left bank has been using them unilaterally, unauthorizedly, and uncoordinatedly for years, violating the international rules established by the International Telecommunication Union and the European Conference of Postal and Telecommunications Administrations.

During the discussions, aspects related to the execution of postal services on both banks of the Nistru and the difficulties faced by the collaborators of SOE "Poșta Moldovei" in this regard, especially on the Cocieri plateau were also addressed, reiterating the primary need for ensuring the free movement to offer high-quality and timely postal services to the population of this region, which also represents a social-humanitarian element.

The experts from Chisinau mentioned the need for Tiraspol to depoliticize the issue of the unconditional access of SOE "The Post of Moldova" collaborators in the districts on the left bank of the Nistru river and highlighted the necessary measures to be taken to ensure compliance with the existing rules regarding the delivery of postal items.
