

A public lecture was held in Cahul on the conflicts in the Black Sea region



Deputy Prime Minister for reintegration Oleg Serebrian held today a public lesson for the students and the teaching staff of Cahul "Bogdan Petriceicu Hasdeu" State University about the conflicts in the Black Sea region.

The lecture took place as a result of the Deputy Prime Minister's visit to Cahul for attendance of the Government meeting.

During his speech, the Deputy Prime Minister referred to the current situation in the Transnistrian settlement process, the challenges faced by the Republic of Moldova in the context of the war in Ukraine and the priorities for the next period.

The students showed interest for the Transnistrian topic; a question-and-answer session followed at the end of the lecture.
