

The Government has improved the mechanism for selecting and implementing the most competitive projects, financed through allocations for the reintegration activities



During today's meeting, the Cabinet of Ministries approved the draft Government Decision 'On amending the Government Decision No. 131/2014 for approving the Regulation on the method of selection and record of projects under the Program of Activities for the Reintegration of the Country', developed by the Reintegration Policies Bureau of the State Chancellery.

The draft introduces new amendments to the mechanism of selecting, implementing and recording applications submitted by the central and local public authorities, public institutions and their subdivisions for funding activities with major impact in the Security Zone's localities, following the allocations approved annually by the State Budget Law and the competition held.

The new project would contribute to improve the mechanism for promoting the most competitive activities with key impact on the achievement of the Government's goal of reintegrating the country, as well as making the beneficiaries of the allocations more accountable in the process of reporting the results achieved and how the allocated funds are used for their intended purpose.

The amended mechanism will be implemented at the stage of launching the competition for projects to be funded through the Program of Activities for the Reintegration of the Country for 2023, which will start in the first quarter of next year.
