

The illegal posts from the Security Zone: subject of discussion during the meeting of the Joint Control Commission



The weekly meeting of the Joint Control Commission, held in Bender on 24 November 2022, started with the hearing of the report on the situation in the Security Zone for the period 16-22 November, 2022 of the Joint Military Command.

According to military observers, the presence of unilaterally and abusively installed Transnistrian force posts is still attested in the Security Zone.

Discussions have therefore resumed on the unsolved issue of the illegal posts, which remains at the top of the Commission's agenda for several months.

The Moldovan delegation strongly supported the withdrawal of the illegal posts and of the unauthorized armed personnel from the area of responsibility of the Joint Peacekeeping Forces.

Certain suggestions of the Russian Federation delegation on the issue cannot be accepted by the Moldovan delegation, as they do not correspond to the principles of the basic acts of the peacekeeping operation, and the implementation of the proposed measures does not guarantee the immediate withdraw of the illegal posts and the exclusion of their future resettlement.

No consensus has been reached during the debate; the Commission will meet again next week.
