

# **The meeting of the Deputy Prime Minister for Reintegration with the Ambassador of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the Republic of Moldova**



On Monday, November 27th, Deputy Prime Minister Oleg Serebrian had a meeting with the new Ambassador of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the Republic of Moldova, H.E. Fern Horine.

During the dialogue, the priorities of Chisinau in the field of Transnistrian conflict settlement were discussed, as well as developments in the negotiation process. Oleg Serebrian reiterated that the country's reintegration is a priority for the current government. The European integration process, as well as the Ukrainian army's resistance to Russian aggression, have created favorable conditions for finding comprehensive solutions to this issue.

The Deputy Prime Minister for Reintegration emphasized the importance of the political support provided by the United Kingdom, both in the development processes and through assistance projects aimed at supporting the resolution of the Transnistrian dossier.

Officials expressed full openness to continuing cooperation and expanding it in areas of mutual interest.
