

Weekly meeting of the Joint Control Commission



The Joint Control Commission met on September 30 in Bender.

According to the agenda, the Joint Military Command presented a report on the situation in the Security Zone for the period of September 22-28.

Members of the Joint Control Commission have inquired about the implementation of the planned actions at two posts of the Joint Peacekeeping Forces located on both banks of the Nistru river, near Vadul-lui-Voda. Assurances have been given that works are in line with the schedule agreed and by the end of 2021 their functioning will be improved so as not to affect the free movement of citizens.

The activity of the working group that examines the circumstances of the emergence of an illegal post of "border guards" near Zahorna village was discussed. The post was installed by Tiraspol authorities on the site of the Joint Peacekeeping Forces post, removed in 1999.

The malignant intentions of members of the working group appointed by Tiraspol were highlighted. They oppose the fulfillment of the task and even promote the revision of the decision agreed by all components of the Joint Control Commission.

Representatives of the OSCE Mission informed the Joint Control Commission about the results of the Security Zone monitoring between September 1-30, 2021. According to the provided information, there is a line of concrete blocks between Bender and Varnita localities, at the intersection of Matnev and 27th April streets, which hinder the free movement of people. Also, Tiraspol has established a check-point with so-called "border guards" next to the ferryboat station in Slobozia, which clearly breaks prior

agreements.

The Delegation of the Republic of Moldova condemns the serious violation by the Tiraspol exponents of the documents of the peacekeeping mission and will continue to insist on removal of the illegal posts in the Security Zone.
