

Nearly 414 thousand doses of anti-Covid-19 vaccine have been distributed to the residents of the Transnistrian region



Between March 2021 and January 2022, localities in the Transnistrian region received multiple doses of vaccine against COVID-19, the majority of which were redirected from the humanitarian aid batches received by the Republic of Moldova, in accordance with the principle of proportionality and in compliance with acts issued by the competent national authorities.

Thus, currently, according to the available information, 413.807 doses of anti-COVID-19 vaccine have been distributed for medical use in the administrative units on the left bank of the Nistru River and in the municipality of Bender, as follows:

AstraZeneca – 19 510 doses;

Sinopharm – 25 001 doses;

Moderna – 28 040 doses;

Johnson&Johnson/Janssen – 29 600 doses;

Pfizer/BioNTech-Comirnaty – 64 656 doses;

Sinovac – 65 000 doses;

Sputnik V – 182 000 doses.

In addition, recently, in accordance with the provisions of the Ministry of Health, 30 oxygen concentrators and 10 respirators with BiPAP accessories and components that will aid medical personnel in combatting the COVID-19 infection and recovery of affected individuals have been distributed to the localities from the Eastern districts of the country.
