

Meeting of the Deputy Prime Minister for reintegration with the Minister of State for the Armed Forces of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland



Deputy Prime Minister Oleg Serebrian had a meeting with the Minister of State for the Armed Forces of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, James Heappey, accompanied by a delegation from the British Ministry of Defence, which undertook a documentation visit in the Republic of Moldova.

During the dialogue, the officials discussed topics related to the security situation in the region, the developments recorded in the Transnistrian settlement process, the efforts of the authorities of the Republic of Moldova to contribute to maintaining stability and security while adapting to the new regional realities and the challenges generated by the war in the neighboring country - Ukraine.

The efforts undertaken by the national institutions to manage vulnerabilities and solve problems arising from the complex nature of the regional situation were evoked, with the preservation of the dialogue dedicated to the Transnistrian settlement in the formats of technical negotiations ("1+1" and that of working groups) and the solving of the current problems of the citizens on both banks of the Nistru River by the authorities of the Republic of Moldova.

The commitment of the authorities from Chisinau to promote the peaceful and political settlement of the Transnistrian conflict within the parameters of the unitary and fully functional state of the Republic of Moldova and with the restoration of all unique spaces between the two banks of the Nistru River was also emphasized.

At the same time, the necessity to achieve the goals of demilitarization and disarmament of the region as factors contributing to advancing the final settlement process and completing the desired reintegration of the country was highlighted.
