

The Working Group meeting on Civil Status and Documentation was held for the second time this year



The Working Group meeting on civil status and documentation was held on October 28, 2022, for the second time this year and was attended by experts from both banks of the Nistru river and representatives of the '5+2' negotiation format. The delegation from Chisinau was led by Deputy Director of the Public Services Agency Mr. Francisco Talmaci, coordinator of the working group.

The discussions focused primarily on current issues regarding the documentation of citizens with civil status documents, specifying the services provided by the territorial subdivisions of the Public Services Agency (PSA) that serve the residents of the localities from the left bank of the Nistru river and Bender.

It was mentioned that the issue of civil status documents by the PSA at the request of the residents of the Transnistrian region is a continuous process, carried out in order to ensure the rights and freedoms of these citizens and document them with national design documents.

A separate topic of the discussions was the common declaration model regarding the expression of consent to the processing of personal data that is to correspond to the rigors in force from the field and to be used in the process of sending, obtaining, and verifying information regarding the respective civil status facts.

Another topic addressed by Chisinau during the meeting concerned the exchange of information regarding the registers of civil status documents drawn up until 1944.

The date of the next meeting will be established in working order.
