

Regional security situation and country's reintegration were discussed during the meeting of the Deputy Prime Minister for reintegration with officials of the French Ministry of Armed Forces



Deputy Prime Minister Oleg Serebrian met today with the delegation of the French Ministry of Armed Forces, which is on a fact-finding visit to our country, accompanied by French Ambassador to Chisinau Paul Graham.

During the talks, the officials discussed topics related to the security situation in the region, developments in the Transnistrian settlement process, the energy crisis, etc.

Efforts made by national institutions to manage all problems and vulnerabilities arising from the complex regional situation were evoked, with further implementation of various positive measures in relation to Moldovan citizens from the Transnistrian region.

It was also noted that the vision of a peaceful settlement of the Transnistrian conflict, which will set out the parameters of the region's status within the unitary and reintegrated state of the Republic of Moldova, is a concern and commitment of the Chisinau authorities. Deputy Prime Minister Oleg Serebrian also stressed that the European Union must play a greater role in the country's reintegration process, which must be harmonised with Moldova's EU integration process.

In this context, the need was stressed for parallel progress on the objectives of demilitarisation and democratisation of the region, with gradual alignment of processes with the legal rigours in force and the achievement of the goal of full

reintegration.
